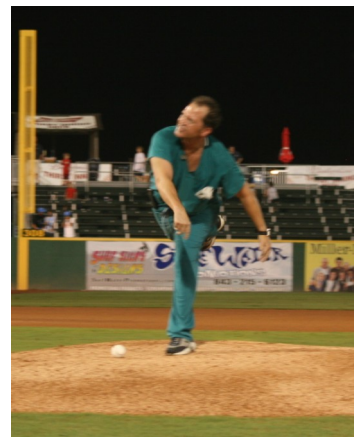

Growing Through Grief Together



Tidelands Community Hospice will offer a parent-child grief workshop where children and adolescents (ages 6 – 16) who have lost a loved one will come with their parent or other close family member to talk about their loss. This three-part workshop, offered one night a week for three weeks, will give adults and children who attend an opportunity to express their grief, while teaching and modeling good parent-child communication regarding their loss. The time spent together will use a variety of teaching methods – video presentation, formal instruction, group activities, craft projects, etc. – to equip participants with “tools” to better handle their grief going forward.

The goal of the workshop is to help parents and children better understand themselves, each other, and the grief they are experiencing. It is hoped that the knowledge and skills learned will equip them to better navigate the difficult days that lie ahead.

This event is open to families served by Tidelands Community Hospice and to the general public. Interested participants please contact Harrison Grey (843-546-3410) to register.
